

Step-dancing Sisters to Appear in Minot

The Seattle sister group, the Gothard Sisters will make their appearance at the North Dakota State Fair this week as part of their summer tour of the Midwest.

The three sisters are champion Irish dancers and musicians who use their talents to perform entertaining shows for all ages across the country.

Their shows include fast fiddle numbers, singing ballads, and Irish dancing incorporated into dance numbers featuring country, Irish, flamenco, and rock music, as well as stories, educational tidbits, and a good time for everyone.

The three Gothard sisters have been playing music and dancing from a very young age. The girls played classical violin for many years before trying their hand at fiddling and they already have four recordings to their credit, Christmas, Classical and Irish fiddling CDs as well as their very latest release, "Celtic Rainbow," in 2009.

Greta, Willow and Solana are also competitive champion Irish dancers, who have participated in the World Championships of Irish dance four times in a row in places as far away as Belfast, N. Ireland and Glasgow, Scotland.

In the last year alone, these fiddling sisters have danced their way across the country, performing in Indiana, Wisconsin, North Dakota, Idaho, Montana, Washington and Georgia among other states and wowing audiences with their fun, yet classy family-oriented shows.

Greta, 22, Willow, 20, and Solana, 14, will be performing here in North Dakota on July 24th-28th at 1:00, 3:00 and 5:00 every day.
